City Mangers Report: Jared reported that Region 4 Development will be in February's meeting to close out the grant for the well now that the project is nearing completion. The pump for the well has not yet shipped, but ID power should be out within the next week or so to finish running power to the pumphouse. He had nothing to report on 1900S as we are waiting, I hear whether the grant has been awarded, it will be the first part of March before we know anything on that. Jared applied for the SMILES grant. This grant will award the city 5000 dollars to make improvements, Jared thought it would be nice to hang welcome banners or update Christmas lights. February 27th is when we will know if we are awarded that grant, and funds won't be available till April, so further discussion will take place at that time to decide the use of that money. Jared and AJ will work this week and next to start taking Christmas lights down.
